




## HM18N50A / HM18N50F 500V N-Channel MOSFET

### General Description

This Power MOSFET is produced using Maple semi's advanced planar stripe DMOS technology. This advanced technology has been especially tailored to minimize on-state resistance, provide superior switching performance, and withstand high energy pulse in the avalanche and commutation mode. These devices are well suited for high efficiency switched mode power supplies, active power factor correction based on half bridge topology.

- Low gate charge ( typical 69nC)
- High ruggedness




Figure 1. On-Region Characteristics




Figure 2. Transfer Characteristics




Figure 3. On-Resistance Variation vs  
Drain Current and Gate Voltage




Figure 4. Body Diode Forward Voltage

and Temperature




Figure 5. Capacitance Characteristics






Figure 6. Gate Charge Characteristics




**Figure 7. Breakdown Voltage Variation vs Temperature**




**Figure 8. On-Resistance Variation vs Temperature**




Figure 11-1. Transient Thermal Response Curve for HM18N50A






Figure 11-2. Transient Thermal Response Curve for HM18N50F


### Gate Charge Test Circuit & Waveform
